More control of speed through the village.

Speed through village should be 20 mph.

Lower speed limits past Boxgrove Stores and B and B and school along The Street.

Double yellow lines to prevent parking outside Boxgrove School.

Parking outside Boxgrove School VERY DANGEROUS. Why not use the car park - a one minute walk? Cars going S - N have to go onto wrong side of the road to pass.

Stop parking outside of school.

Lower speed limits through Halnaker.

Lowers speed through Halnaker. We would like to see the speed limit lower after Halnaker by our houses.

Introduce a pathway from Halnaker to Boxgrove, very unsafe on A285.

Roundabout at Halnaker crossroads? Dangerous getting out from village across to Goodwood.

Ban any future flashing signage of road side.

Traffic lights at Tangmere roundabout opening on to The Street at Boxgrove.

Cycle paths would be helpful especially with the vehicles speeding through the village.

Change bridle way to cycle path, Town Lane.

Cycle path from Boxgrove to Chichester.

Needs good cycle routes, not just for leisure but also to destinations such as Chichester, easy and direct.

I would like a cycle path A285 as I find it too hairy to cycle to work in Chichester. I would prefer to cycle as my main mode of transport. A good cycle route and footpath would encourage more people. The cutting on the cycle path into the old A27 at Maudlin is scary in the darker evenings - when I would prefer to walk / cycle otherwise the road is too fast to cycle.

ENVIRONMENT AND HERITAGE

Need speedy and competent repairs to Halnaker Windmill.
